

Project Serve

What is Project Serve?

Projects Serve enables youth to reach beyond themselves effecting positive change in their local community and worldwide. Project Serve is a three-level mission experience training youth in teamwork, commitment and leadership. Participants learn to think about the needs of others and are given the opportunity to serve the homeless and less fortunate in Wetaskiwin, Edmonton and a community in a developing country. With a focus on God's heart for the poor, teens find joy in serving others and recognize how God is at work in their lives and in the world.

Who can attend?

Students in grades 10, 11, and 12 who want to make a difference in their world.

Where are we going?

We have no confirmed location at this point in time, but we are prayerfully considering The Gambia in West Africa to work with the local Youth for Christ chapter to help them build a university.

How will we accomplish that?

There will be weekly meetings in order to train and grow as a team with a serve trip at the end of each of the first two training levels. Serve trips can consist of volunteering at soup kitchens, helping with fundraising events, and any various other activities throughout the community. Project Serve is a 3 level mission trip experience primarily for youth from any background.

- Level 1 consists of 8 training sessions about teamwork, commitment, leaders and followers. It finishes with a service trip to Edmonton to prepare a meal for the homeless community at the Mustard Seed.
- Level 2 consists of 6 training sessions about serving without recognition, meeting others needs and finishes with a service trip to non profit organizations where we practice behind the scenes work.
- Level 3 consists of 8 training sessions with a focus on resolving conflict, motivation for being a part of the team, and learning about the country we will be serving in. And finishes off with an international service trip to a third world country.

Student Requirements/Expectations

- 1. Application form completed
- 2. Entry interview with staff supervisor
- 3. Signed Letter of Commitment
- 4. Signed Project Serve Participant Covenant
- 5. Participants may not advance to another Level without successful completion of previous level and endorsement from the team leader
- 6. Participants may repeat a level if not successfully completed or if they are not ready, unwilling or unable to advance
- 7. Attendance at all training is **mandatory**.
- 8. Any deposits for trips are non-refundable but may be held for subsequent trips
- 9. Valid Passports must be obtained for admission to level three
- 10. Fundraise the set amount to be able to come on the international Level 3 service trip

Objectives:

- 1. Teach commitment
- 2. Team work
- 3. Leadership
- 4. Learn to understand and work with those who are different from us
- 5. Learn to help and serve even if there is no recognition
- 6. Make an impact locally and globally

(Sept 11) – Training sessions commence and Parent Meeting to follow at 5pm (first session only) *Sessions will be every Monday from 4-6 and are mandatory in order to participate in the final trip.
